Mileage Contest Rules

1. Classes:	Yearly (Annual)	Male	Female

2. The yearly contest begins in February and ends in December. Each year the rider in each class with the most mileage for that year will receive a Harley Davidson World Gift Certificate/Award. Each class will have three places to finish. All three places in each class will receive an award based on mileage for that year.

3. To enter the yearly mileage contest, the bike must be ridden to a chapter meeting and beginning mileage recorded by an OKC HOG officer. The beginning mileage will be read in February and March at the chapter meeting and ending mileage will be read in November and December to determine the riders with the most mileage. You must ride your bike to a chapter meeting to have the mileage recorded by an OKC HOG officer. Arrangements will be made for members to have their mileage recorded in later months if necessary. Contact Head Road Captain/Asst. Director.

4. A yuppie award will be presented for the riders in each class with the least amount of miles.

5. Ending mileage for the yearly contest will be **confirmed and recorded at the November/December chapter meeting.**

6. Awards for the yearly mileage contest will be presented at the Chapter Christmas Party.

7. Multiple bike owners can enter more than one bike in the contest, and the mileage for all bikes will be added together for a total mileage for that rider. An entry sheet for each bike is required.

8. If you trade bikes during the contest period, you must confirm the ending mileage for this bike through an OKC HOG officer or present an official document which states your ending mileage. If this is not accomplished, your last recorded mileage for that bike will be used. New Bikes must have a separate entry sheet.

9. Competition is open to all riders/members to include officers. The Assistant Director will collect mileage information for each officer participating in the contest.

10. Any questions pertaining to the contest should be directed to the Assistant Director/Head Road Captain.
