Safety Info

Ned reached out to the folks at OSU-OKC and got this info back:

Our first 3-Wheel Ready to Ride (3WR2R) will be Saturday, May 14th, 8:00am to 5:00pm. This is the free 7 hour 3-wheel motorcycle safety course that we may have told you about when you took the Basic consists of 5 excercises such as braking, swerving and cornering that are conducted at higher speeds and hears than used in the basic course. After the exercises, we will have some riding sessions on our private ¾ mile 2 lane road. The course has a minimum of classroom and no tests, just plenty of riding. All riders must have a current drivers license with the motorcycle endorsement, insurance in the riders name and some experience riding your own 3-wheel motorcycle. If you ride with a passenger, they can take the course with you. Don't wait too long to register because there are limited spots available and they will fill up quickly.

Also, from Edmond Police Department. Lt Todd Strader is the contact for the Edmond Police Department motorcycle classes. They have a Level 1 class scheduled for Saturday May 21st of this year and a Level 2 for Sunday May 22nd.
